Carbon-info.org's top five energy and money saving tips:

- 1) Install one low-energy light bulb. Will save you ~£65 over its life time.
- 2) Switch to renewable energy supplier. Saves ~3000 Kg CO2 and £30 yearly.
- 3) Turn thermostat down 1 degree. Saves ~400 Kg CO2 and £15 every year.
- 4) Switch off stand-by appliances. Could save £8-£12 pounds per year
- 5) When cooking, always use a lid and turn down heat. Saves £2 annually.

For those who want to get involved in the politics of climate change, there is still an opportunity to support Carbon-info.org's letter campaigns. Two letters requesting urgent action by the UK and USA administrations on climate change will be sent to Prime Minister Blair and President Bush later in 2006.

Flemming Bermann further outlined the benefit of the partnership. "Expanding our partnership with OneWorld UK has given our campaigns a huge boost. The response has been fantastic. Not only from the UK, but from all over the world. We have people from China, Australia and Europe participating in our campaigns."
